Student Scholarship Program 2018 Application



THE PROGRAM

Each year, the First Choice Financial Federal Credit Union awards up to \$4,000 in scholarships to those candidates who have demonstrated academic merit and who have engaged in community service upholding the Credit Union philosophy of "people helping people." Scholarship winners will be required to submit their letter of acceptance, and proof of full-time status from the college they will be attending.

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be:

- A First Choice Financial Federal CU member and in good standing with the Credit Union.
- A first-time college bound student.
- Age 21 or younger.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Check each box after completion

1.	The applicant and his/her parent or guardian must sign the Certification and Release
	Authorization.
2.	The signed application must be submitted together with:
	Sealed official high school transcript and unweighted GPA.

Applicant's credit union essay.

Teacher's letter of reference. (2) Required.

3. The application, transcript, essay and letters of recommendation must be returned by the application deadline. If any portion is incomplete or not included, the application will not be considered.

SELECTION PROCESS

Judging will be based on the applicant's academic performance, personal essay, community activities, honors/awards, and letters of recommendation.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Application must be returned to the Credit Union no later than Friday, April 20, 2018.
